

International Student Athletic Eligibility Addendum



International and domestic students are encouraged to participate in a wide range of extracurricular activities that are offered at Red Lion Christian Academy or Tall Oaks Classical School. To be in compliance with the Delaware Interscholastic Athletic Association (DIAA) policy, F1 international students desiring to participate in the middle and high school athletic program are required to agree to the following conditions.

- 1. I am enrolling as a student at Red Lion Christian Academy or Tall Oaks Classical School for educational reasons and not for the purpose of participating in interscholastic athletics. In addition, I was not recruited by the school or any other organization for the purpose of participating in athletics.
- 2. I understand that if I choose to participate in Red Lion's and Tall Oaks' athletic program, my participation is limited to the sub-varsity level for the first year of attendance at the school and I will not be eligible for state tournament competition during that time.
- 3. I understand that if the school does not have a sub-varsity team, then my participation will be limited to practice sessions with the varsity team for the first year of attendance, and I will not be permitted to participate in interscholastic competition.
- 4. I understand that after the first year of attendance at Red Lion Christian Academy or Tall Oaks Classical School, I will become eligible to compete at the varsity level and to participate in state tournament competition.
- 5. I am required to comply with all other school and DIAA policies governing the participation in interscholastic athletic competition.
