Some of the specific areas of testing:

- ❖ will have the ability to identify:
 - lower case alphabet
 - upper case alphabet
 - shapes
 - colors
 - numbers
 - rhyming words
- ❖ will be able to count (as far as possible)
- ❖ will be able to say the alphabet
- ❖ will be able to follow directions
- ❖ will be able to show physical balance and abilities

In addition, we observe:

- ❖ speech development
- ❖ small and large motor skills
- ❖ auditory and visual discrimination
- ❖ auditory memory
- ❖ phonemic awareness

You can best prepare your child for Kindergarten by reading to him/her on a regular basis.
